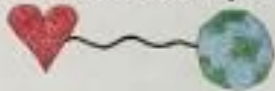

Parents need to continue to make time for themselves.

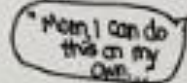

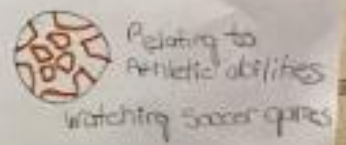
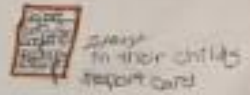
