Using a template in Google Documents, create a resume that demonstrates your understanding of the concepts learned in class as they apply to your family. The following criteria need to be included in your resume.

First & Last Name: Bolded & Centered at the Top of the Page

Address: Directly under your name

<u>Objective</u>: Explain what your own personal definition and purpose are for the family. Must be at least one paragraph (5 sentences) in length.

Education: List all of the schools you've attended, working from present to past; include dates.

Relevant Courses: List any courses that you've taken that would help you complete the work of the family with a brief explanation of how.

Activities & Honors: List at least two activities you've successfully accomplished and/or honors that you've earned that made you and your family proud.

Related Information:

- List & Explain your Family Structure
- Describe the Family Life Cycle Stage your family is currently in
- Share two pros and two cons about living in this particular stage of the life cycle as they apply to YOUR family
- Share and briefly explain 3 Family Strengths your family possesses.
- List 3 examples of Technological advances your family has made since your birth and explain how these advances have made your family time better or worse.
- List 5 Family Functions your family provides and include an example or brief explanation illustrating how

<u>Family References:</u> Provide 3 relatives you are close to and spend time with often. Include their name, address and relationship to you.

Family Summary: Write a paragraph (5 sentences minimum) that explains your contribution(s) to your family.

**Be sure to proofread your resume for spelling and grammatical errors.
