

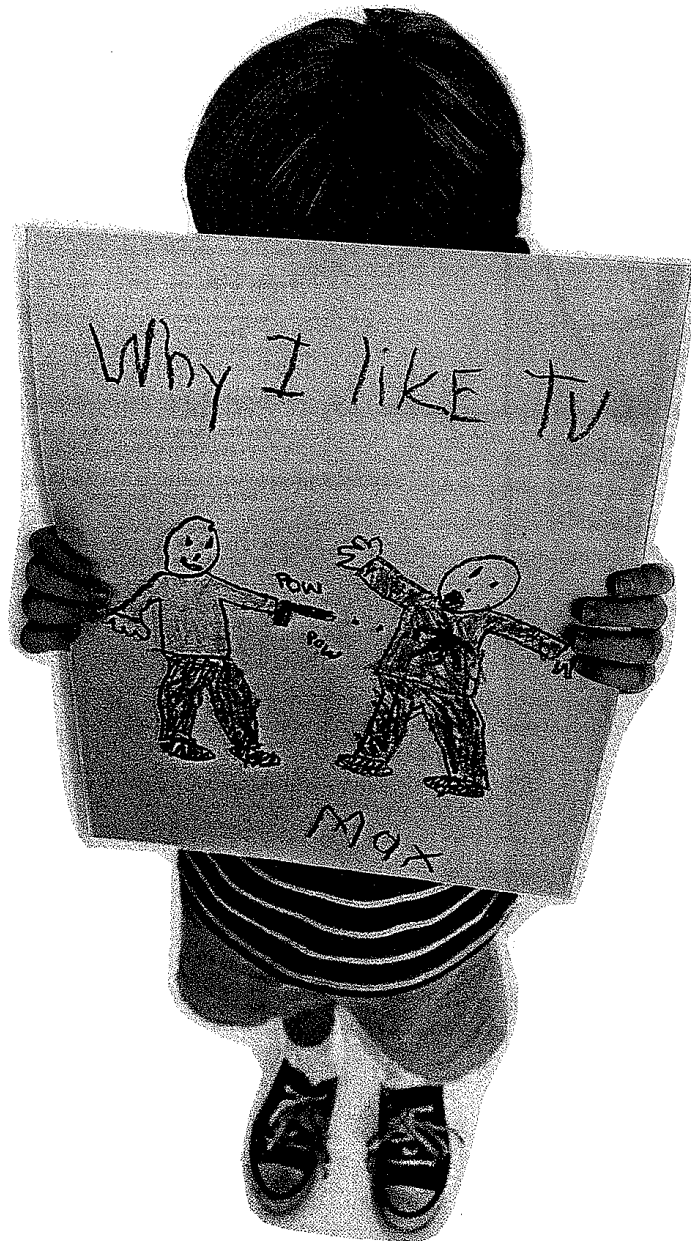
Social Learning Task Rotation Grid

Intro: View the Watching You Video Clip by Rodney Atkins: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oqYUns2YQik> and put the Why I like TV Picture Analysis Photo (see below) on the SMARTBOARD before passing out the task rotation learning grids.

Grid Activities: Allow students to view YouTube clip and photo again if necessary and then complete the mastery, understanding and interpersonal blocks on the grid. Discuss answers and then have students complete the self-expression block as a concluding activity or exit slip. These can either be shared as a class or turned in for a grade.

*Note: Students may use additional paper to complete grid activities.
